

Balla Mart Report the 24th August

There was a lot of stock coming out this week especially in the bullock ring where there was over the 400 mark and there was some great cattle.

With the weather been so cruel land is in an awful state 'Saturated' and this is shoving them out early being so cold and wet

Things worked out great though because the quality would have been hard got anywhere buyers said.

There was plenty of buyers around the ring and online that put a stir under them so they proved to be well up on the last few weeks 'One never knows!'

There was a lot of forward store heifers for feeding and the cows sold well with anything good making just over E3 euro a kg for the Northern trade.

Bullocks 300kg to 400kg averaged 2.94/kg. Store bullocks 400kg to 500kg averaged 3.14p/kg. While heavier bullocks 500kg averaged 3.00/kg.

There was a heavy 720kg [Charolais](#) bullock born June '22 that made E2,500.00 or 3.47/kg from a Clogher - Claremorris farmer.(See link below)

There was some good stores on offer. Lighter store heifers 300 - 400kg averaged 2.83/kg. Heifers 400kg to 500kg averaged 2.98/kg. While 500kg+ averaged 3.02p/kg. A Belgian Blue heifer born Feb '22 weighing 695kg made E2,410.00 or 3.47/kg for a Bellacorrick - Ballina farmer that went to a buyer from the North for breeding.

There was another [Belgian Blue](#) heifer born Sept '23 weighing 420kg that made E2,120.00 or 5.05/kg again for breeding sold by a farmer from Corrandulla - Galway.(See link below)

It was a good sale of dry cows this week with just over 110 on offer and 500kg+ averaged 2.53 this week . There was one strong SIX dry cow born June '19 weighing a ton that made E2,840.00 or 2.84/kg sold by a farmer from Purranes - Hollymount to a factory buyer from the North.
